- Attend mandatory weekly meetings with the VP Equity and other coordinators under the campaigns portfolio.
- Chair or take minutes for meetings attended
- Outreach for campaigns and services undertaken by UTMSU.
- Work with the Equity team to address racism issues that are occurring on an international level through Anti-Oppression workshops as well as educational, hands-on campaigns and events.
- The coordinator will assist the VP Equity in the World University Service Canada (WUSC) program.
- Work with the Campaigns team to organize events such as Unity Through Diversity, XAO and WeTheStudents.
