RE: Anti-Black Racism

Dear UTM students,

Over the past few weeks, there has been a rampant increase in anti-Black racist attacks, notably the heinous murders of Breonna Taylor, George Floyd, Ahmaud Arbery, and - much closer to home - Regis Korchinski-Paquet, a Torontonian. The University of Toronto Mississauga Students' Union (UTMSU) sends its sincerest condolences to the family, friends, and community members impacted by these senseless and vicious acts of violence.

The UTMSU would like to extend its full support and solidarity to the Black people on and off-campus who have faced and continue to face various forms of oppression. This includes but is not limited to police violence, over-policing, mass-incarceration, carding, and the criminalization of blackness in the media. The UTMSU condemns all forms of racism and systemic injustices.

We would like to reaffirm our commitment to supporting the Black and non-Black allies at UTM, across the U of T campuses and within our community. On the behalf of the African Students' Association, Caribbean Connections, and the Black Students' Association, the UTMSU would like to make a donation of \$500 to the family of Regis Korchinski-Paquet to support them in their fight for justice.

The UTMSU understands how difficult this time is and encourages all students and community allies to seek out resources to better understand how systems of oppression greatly impact Black people.
