- T. Afrah: working on orientation, trying to work with Environmental Health and Safety Committee to get our in-person orientation approved by the university, presented at various trainings like Leader and Peer Support Group training, working on Sauga fest, also re-recognition for most clubs are done so they can get ready to go

#6.	FALL RETURN TO CAMPUS - UTMSU OPERATIONS - FOR INFORMATION

Board Meeting #5 of the University of Toronto at Mississauga Students' Union Friday, August 27th, 2021 • UTMSU, Student Center, Room 100

Nour: working all summer on Safe Return to Campus for Fall, since March 2020 capacity and traffic in Student Centre was very limited, most services were provided online or appointment online

What to expect when re-opening of Student Centre:

- 1. Currently working on our SAT, 19 page-document to the university about how we will be opening Student Centre
- 2. Will still have two staff in info booth with plexiglass and all lines are marked for social distance
- 3. A lot of discount fees were not passed out because those places were closed, but now they're open so will be giving them out again
- 4. Print centre will be open, we have 3 printers but only 2 will be open for social distancing and only 2 customers allowed at the same time, also everything has to be done prior to coming into Student Centre; pay online and send in-printing services before (no cash or coins)
- 5. Printers and info-booth will be cleaned by staff hourly
- 6. Blind Duck Pub has been operating all this time for take-out services, have been coming up with a map for seating distribution for dining-in
- 7. New furniture, new fireplace, lounge, arranged in a way for socially distance at Student Centre
- 8. Campus group offices are first come first serve basis, capacity of each office is just 1 person currently so will be used for storage, will also be providing locker if can't store all materials
- 9. Some of the Executives have come back in-person, maximum of 4 execs at one time in the UTMSU office, also have hybrid-working hours where Executives are rotating
- 10. BOD and volunteers can come to Green Room, capacity limit 7 or 8 people
- 11. Waiting for final approval of Student Centre re-opening; anticipate before September 7th we will receive confirmation
- 12. Contemplating on whether to implement policy for access to Student Centre but university is already doing that, so all staff have gone to training and for situations where students would not follow COVID protocols
- 13. Speaking with lawyers to implement policy of our own for Full-time and Part-time staff; but first needs to be approved by PCC and BOD first
