<b>Violations Made:</b>	March 10, 2022
<b>Demerit Points:</b>	Five (5) per candidate
<p>On March 10, 2022 Change UTM's President Candidate participated in a third-party student group, Transparent UTMSU, discussion session via Instagram and Discord live stream. At the end of the virtual event, Transparent UTMSU noted that they endorsed Change UTM.</p> <p>As per the EPC, Change UTM is accountable for the actions and inactions of their non-arm's-length-party. Attached is a screenshot of Transparent UTMSU's post on Instagram instructing UTM members to vote against Inspire UTM, Change UTM's opposition, in the Spring 2022 Election.</p> <p>Considering this form of sabotage against fellow candidates that contradicts the spirit and purpose of elections, each candidate apart of Change UTM will be levied 5 demerit points as dictated in the Election Procedure Code on page 22 under 'Fair Play' violations.</p> <p>It should be noted that the CRO waited 24 hours after the endorsement was issued to determine the validity of the violation and designate demerit points given that the Instagram post was shared on March 8, 2022.</p>
