UTMSU's International Students' Bursary (Winter 2023 Application)

The UTMSU's International Students' Bursary is designed to assist registered undergraduate international students who are paying international fees. Additionally, it is for international students who have proven they are in financial need and are having difficulty financing their post-secondary education.

You must complete all pages of this application and explain in detail any exceptional expenses or circumstances. This bursary is based solely on financial need. The collected information is used to determine eligibility and will remain strictly confidential. If you applied for any previous bursary, you are still welcome to apply to this one. All bursary applications are evaluated after the deadline. Only successful applicants will be contacted.

How to Submit Your Application

Applications are due **February 12, 2023 at 11:59 pm**. You can submit your application **via email or in-person**. Your application **MUST**

1. Have all sections completed (sections A-I)
2. If you are submitting via email, Section (A) must be completed using this google form: <https://forms.gle/a8P7BY61mGHHYPkE7>. This will be made clear once you arrive at Section (A).
3. Include all documents on the "Document Checklist" (as listed in "Section H"). This includes a personal statement (which is outlined in "Section G").

To submit in-person, hand in all of the items listed above to the UTMSU Info Booth in the Student Centre.

Late applications will not be accepted. Applications that do not include all of the items listed above will not be accepted.
