- WUSC (World University Services Canada) a non-profit organisation that supports women's education and refugees from 3rd world countries to study at UTM
 - WUSC Committee will collab with the Housing Committee in August to educate students on what WUSC is
 - Will be receiving the WUSC student in August have been preparing for their arrival
- Co-op
 - Worked with the EEU
 - Survey has been finalised students can give feedback
 - Will be distributed to humanities and social science students & the corresponding academic societies
