You will work closely with our Communications team, under the guidance of the Graphics and Communications Coordinator to create compelling visual content for our website, social media, and promotional materials.

Responsibilities:

- Must complete a minimum of three (3) office hours a week.
- Attend mandatory biweekly meetings with the President, the associates, and other coordinators under the supervision of the President.
- Responsible for capturing memorable moments at UTMSU events and actions.
- The Photographer will use their tools along with a strong artistic vision to present their unique perspective of the world—whether taking portraits of people or documenting a special event.
- Work closely with marketing, communications, and event planning teams to understand and fulfill photographic needs.
- Be present at various events, both onsite and offsite, to capture key moments and interactions. This includes UTMSU events as well as events for campus groups who may request a photography service from the UTMSU
- Work within deadlines to provide timely photo deliverables.
- Maintain an organized library of photos for easy access and retrieval for future use.
- Utilize and manage photography equipment, ensuring it is in good working condition for all shoots.
- Is responsible for reporting all accomplishments and hours of work to the VP Internal & Service, the President and the Executive Director on a bi-weekly basis, with all projects and work assigned.
