- Work with other LGBTQ2S+ clubs on campus
- Work on promoting Pride Week, and other events during the Xpressions Against Oppression social week.
- Serve as a resource, consultant and liaison to the campus community.

- Provide educational resource materials to individuals and group on LGBTQ2S+ and Accessibility issues
- Provide leadership in the development of student leadership initiatives, including advising student organizations, and fostering student learning and development by serving as a role model, mentor, student advocate and educator.
- Assist in the development of policies and procedures, newsletters, brochures, web pages, etc. that can be used to promote diversity.
- Lead, encourage, and work cooperatively with University departments, faculty, staff, and students to improve recruitment and retention of LGBTQ2S+ and accessibility students.
- Is responsible for reporting all accomplishments and hours of work to the VP Internal and the VP Equity on a bi-weekly basis, with all projects and work assigned.

- Highly organized and able to multitask.
- Detail oriented and solution focused.
- Excellent communication skills both written and oral.
- Passion for Equity initiatives.
- Self-motivated and Dedicated: able to complete tasks without being supervised.
