Job Description:

Responsibilities:

- Must complete a minimum of six (6) office hours a week in the UTMSU Food Centre.
- Attend mandatory weekly meetings with the VP Equity, the Equity associate, and other coordinators under the supervision of the VP Equity.
- Coordinate Food Centre orders, pick-ups, and volunteer team.
- Raise awareness about the Food Centre services through events and campaigns.
- Ensure that all necessary materials (such as groceries, storage bags, special request items, etc.) are stocked in the Food Centre for grocery pick-ups and events.
- Develop strategies to improve the means of distribution, collection, and inventory of food items.
- Organize events in collaboration with community Food Banks and similar services.

- Report all accomplishments and hours of work to the VP Equity on a bi-weekly basis, with all projects and work assigned.

- Highly organized.
- Solid understanding of the impact of food insecurity.
- Self-motivated and dedicated.
- Excellent communication skills - both written and oral.
- Punctual.
- Adhere to confidentiality.
- Ability to work with and lead a team.
- Passionate about social justice and equity issues.
- Organization and attention to detailed information are necessary skills.
- Budgeting skills are necessary.
