### Job Description:

You will work closely with our Communications team, under the guidance of the Graphics and Communications Coordinator to create compelling visual content for our website, social media, and promotional materials.

### Responsibilities:

- Work with the rest of the Communications team to capture effective representation of events, services, and campaigns. Work closely with marketing, communications, and event planning teams to understand and fulfill videographic/photographic needs.
- Attend mandatory biweekly meetings with the Graphics and Communications Coordinator, videographer, and other communications staff to update on deliverables and receive feedback.
- Responsible for capturing memorable moments at UTMSU events and actions.
- Be present at various events, both onsite and offsite, to capture key moments and interactions. This includes UTMSU events as well as events for campus groups who may request a photography service from the UTMSU.
- Responsible for post-production editing of raw files.
- Experience with video editing.
- Work within deadlines to provide timely photo deliverables.
- Maintain an organized library of photos for easy access and retrieval for future use.

- Utilize and manage photography equipment, ensuring it is in good working condition for all shoots.
- Is responsible for reporting all accomplishments and hours of work to the Graphics and Communications Coordinator, the VP Internal, the President and the Executive Director on a bi-weekly basis, with all projects and work assigned.
